

## New names of oak floorboard grades

Old name	New name	Description
Natural	<b>Excellence</b>	natural colour and structure, free ring arrangement, natural tints, single, bright, strongly intergrown knots up to 10 mm in diameter acceptable, black pointed knots acceptable, sapwood unacceptable
Rustikal	<b>Harmony</b>	very diversified wood colour and structure, strong tints, healthy knots up to 35 mm in diameter acceptable, sapwood unacceptable. In engineered floorboards small losses after knots up to 10 mm in diameter are permitted
Country	<b>Country</b> (bez zmian)	very diversified wood colour and structure, strong tints, joined, cracked knots or with losses up to 65 mm in diameter acceptable (holes and shakes are filled with a suitable wood filler), closed core acceptable, sapwood unacceptable
Antique	<b>Antique</b> (bez zmian)	bardzo urozmaicona barwa i struktura drewna, mocne zabarwienia, sęki dopuszczalne bez ograniczeń, dopuszczalne sęki popękane, z ubytkami (ubytki i pęknięcia są fabrycznie szpachlowane), dopuszczalny rdzeń, niedopuszczalny biel
Country Polar	<b>Polar</b>	elements with sapwood and bright tints (mix of grades Excellence, Harmony oraz Country)
Rustikal with insect trails	<b>Old Wood Harmony</b>	elements selected for their unique insect trails, all other characteristics as in Harmony grade
Country with insect trails	<b>Old Wood Country</b>	elements selected for their unique insect trails, all other characteristics as in Country grade

grade names are also changing for skirting boards
